

# - Celebrating our - 60th Birthday

We are very proud to be celebrating the Marina's 60th birthday this year. Soldiers Point couldn't always lay claim to being the more sedate end of the Tomaree Peninsula and actually has an interesting history.


Originally known as Friendship Point, the area name was later changed owing to a small garrison of soldiers which was established there in 1826 to intercept convict escapees making their way across the narrow stretch of water to the settlement further south.

Fast forward over a century and the original Thonwhalla wharf was built in 1948, with the boatshed built and completed in 1954 for Fred Hansen (who later became NSW Police Commissioner).

A succession of owners followed over the years, each adding more to the existing infrastructure.

In 2000 the marina was purchased by Clippers Anchorage who have totally rebuilt both the floating marina and refurbished the land facilities to make it into the world class facility we have today.



approximately 450hrs. The sculpture is displayed alongside the chess tables on Sunset Beach adjacent to the marina. Created in 2013, the 240 kg sculpture received the Peer Award by fellow contributors in the exclusive 2013 Swell Sculpture Festival on the Gold Coast. Mike commented "This award meant more to me than any other as it was voted by my peers in my first exhibition. The level of interest is because of the material I use, so I also loved watching and listening to people's reactions to my work" he said.

## MARINE RESCUE

Marine Rescue Port Stephens, manned by volunteers, has been in operation for over 30 years. Their mission is to provide an effective 24 hour Marine Radio and Search and Rescue response to the boating community in accordance with State and National policy.

The Radio Base is a state of the art facility and monitors VHF, HF and 27MHz radio frequencies and has vessel monitoring, reporting and tracking capabilities, including the detection of AIS. In addition to coordinating rescues and assists, the Radio Base provides on request local weather and other information relating to safe boating in the Port Stephens area to the boating public.

Marine Rescue Port Stephens, has two life boats, one for high speed in shore assistance, and one capable of all-weather off shore assistance. These area vessel are also available 24/7, and at short notice.



## THE MYALL LAKES

Permanent long time marina guests Matt Ruwald and his wife Rosie have spent a considerable amount of time with family, friends and by themselves over the years, exploring and enjoying the beautiful Myall Lakes— a leisurely 4 hour motor from Soldiers Point Marina.

The extensive waterways of the Myall Lakes system offer an excellent range of boating opportunities. When full, the Myall Lakes covers an area of around 5,800 hectares of coastal brackish waterways, located within the Myall Lakes National Park. The waterway is made up of 3 major lakes, the Myall Lake, the Boolambayte Lake and the Broadwater. The 3 lakes are connected by the "narrows" and are all fully navigable. The lake system is recognised internationally with the National Park being listed as a RAMSAR Wetland.

"We love coming up here to enjoy the peace and tranquillity and often we are the only boat here" said Matt. We kayak and bushwalk and enjoy all the wildlife, including 266 species of birds, dingos, wallabies, koalas, pelicans, goannas and possums.

"There is something for everyone up here however it is advisable to bring all your supplies with you and to ensure you have enough fuel for the return trip as supplies are limited whilst at the Lakes" he said.

Fishing is a wonderful relaxing pastime and the Myall Lakes offer a number of eatable species with summer the best time to enjoy (bream, whiting, Australian salmon, flathead and mullet), however it is important to note that

parts of these waters are protected as part of the Port Stephens - Great Lakes Marine Park. Please check at <a href="https://www.mpa.nsw.gov.au/psglmp.html">www.mpa.nsw.gov.au/psglmp.html</a> to ensure you only fish in the appropriate location.

For those with smaller boats, large and smaller campgrounds are plentiful thus allowing you to bring your boat in and tie it to a tree whilst onshore. A mobile sewage barge funded by the Waterways Authority of NSW operates on the lake system and is free to private boat owners. A wharf-based sewage pump out facility is located at Bombah Point and is also free.

Boats with a draft of more than one metre should travel at high tide, which is about 2.5 hours after Fort Denison. Aim to be 30 minutes upstream from Tea Gardens at the top of the tide. While the Myall River is marked with navigational lights and markers, it is recommended to travel during daylight hours.

## **VIEW YOUR BOAT 24/7**

The Soldiers Point Marina Live Berth View camera is an innovative service that allows marina customers to view their boat at the marina from a 360 degree view web camera overlooking the marina.

When you login, the camera pans and tilts automatically to your berth or mooring so you can watch your boat live from your computer at home or the office.

The Live Berth View camera has been developed to protect the privacy of all visitors and customers of the marina. This is done by restricting the controls available so that the user can only zoom in and out of their boats position. Live Berth View also requires a username and password to login.

Boat owner Jenni Keddie found the camera very reassuring and helpful during a recent storm..."it was good to be able to log on and check our boat during the storm and see it was safe" she said. Jenni also added "I gave my children in Melbourne the login password to look at the boat and they caught us having cocktails on the deck – I might just have to change the password to keep our privacy" she said.



Scuttlebutt is printed using soy based inks on paper manufactured from sources with Responsible Forestry Practices and is Elementaly chlorine free.
